NEW DESIGNATIONS FOR PARKLEX PRODUCTS

After having applied Standard UNE-EN 438, which covers High Pressure Decorative Laminates (HPL), our Parklex products will be changing their designations.

Parklex products will be referred to in the following manner:

PARKLEX 1000

The letters E and D are added to Parklex 1000, corresponding to:

E: Panels for outdoor use

D: For use in applications subject to extreme conditions

There are two options within the Parklex 1000 line: Fire-resistant (F) and Standard (S).
As a result, the new designations for Parklex 1000 are:

Parklex 1000 EDF (previously Parklex 1000 M1)

Parklex 1000 EDS (previously Parklex 1000 M2)

PARKLEX 700

The letters C and G are added to Parklex 700, corresponding to:

C: Compact panels

G: For use in applications subject to general or moderate use

There are two options within the Parklex 700 line: Fire-resistant (F) and Standard (S).
As a result, the new designations for Parklex 700 are:

Parklex 700 CGF (previously Parklex 700 M1)

Parklex 700 CGS (previously Parklex 700 M2)

PARKLEX 500

The letters V and D are added to Parklex 500, corresponding to:

V: Panels for use in vertical applications

D: For use in applications subject to extreme conditions

There are two options within the Parklex 500 line: Fire-resistant (F) and Standard (S).
As a result, the new designations for Parklex 500 are:

Parklex 500 VDF (previously Parklex 500 M2)

Parklex 500 VDS (previously Parklex 500 M4)

PARKLEX 2000

The letters H and D are added to Parklex 2000, corresponding to:

H: Panels for horizontal application

D: For use in applications subject to extreme conditions

There are two options within the Parklex 2000 line: Fire-resistant (F) and Standard (S).

As a result, the new designations for Parklex 2000 are:

Parklex 2000 HDF (previously Parklex 2000 M1)

Parklex 2000 HDS (previously Parklex 2000 M3)
